Description


- The Detector is Photoelectric Smoke Detector. It was designed on theory in which the light emits diffusively to various directions when reflecting onto the smoke cell.
- Soon as the detector sensors the desired density of the smoke, after several times of confirmation as a flame smoke, it then transfers into signal and transmits to signal receiver or control disc to change the fire alarm or activate the equipment of fire resistance gate and smoke expellantion value.

Features


- For security system.


